## Dear Parents and Families,

Welcome to the spring term! We have lots of fun activities planned for the children. We are focusing on schematic play alongside lots of other activities.

Schemas are described as patterns of repeated behaviour which allow children to explore and express developing ideas and thoughts through their play and exploration.

The repetitive actions of schematic play allow children to construct meaning in what they are doing. Babies and young children learn best through opportunities to engage in active learning through hands on experiences. These opportunities allow babies and children to problem solve, question, predict, imagine, speculate and develop independent choices as they make decisions in an area they are familiar with. Some of the most common types of observed schema include -

Trajectory, Transporting, Rotation, Connecting, Enclosing, Positioning, Enveloping, Orientation. We will be incorporating these schemes into to planning over the next few weeks.
