Dear Parents and Families,

Welcome to our September newsletter! What an exciting summer we have had with lots of beautiful sunshine and fun filled activities. We are all looking forward to a wonderful September with fantastic activities planned. To start of our September term the topic will be 'All about me.' This topic will run for the next two weeks, with a variety of activities to encourage the children to talk about themselves, their families and their emotions. As part of this topic all the children will get the chance to create/paint a self portrait!

The Jelly tots are also learning 'All about me'. They will be using mirrors to look at themselves, pointing out different body parts. They will also be doing some body painting to encourage them to learn the names of different body pars e.g. arms, legs, fingers etc..



Leading on form the 'All about me' topic the children will look into where they live, which will lead nicely onto our topic of the Solar System. There are a variety of activities planned for this including creating our own solar system using paper Mache. Children are welcome to come to nursery dressed as astronauts that week. (Please label any costumes) There will be a range of sensory activities related to space available for the children to explore.

The Jelly tots will be exploring the topic of space by using dark dens and torches. They will have a rocket tent and some space small world toys such as rockets and astronauts. They will be encouraged to make marks and create there own rocket with the jelly tots team!
